

SCC Minutes – October 19, 2009

2. Approval of Agenda Items: motion to accept – Annette; seconded- Mark
3. Minutes of last meeting: Leanne S. briefly went over the minutes from last meeting; motion to accept – Denis; seconded – Annette
4. Treasurer's Report – detailed copy of report was provided; SCC balance - \$10,580.97 there is still money to come out of that amount (smart boards + installation); if someone wishes to see a copy of this report, they can request to see it; motion to accept – Denis; seconded- Annette
5. Goal setting – we agreed that we need to be a lot clearer and structured with our goals/expectations – meeting at beginning of year and at the end of the year to review goals and upcoming goals; Mark made the motion to purchase 3 more smart boards \$5,000+matching grant; seconded – Annette; we need \$11,000 set aside for field trips
